MEMORANDUM FOR Child, Youth and School Services Patrons

SUBJECT: Child, Youth, and Schools (CYS) Services Fee Policy School Year (SY) 2015-2016

1. Every year the Department of Defense issues an updated fee policy which outlines how each military service will determine fees for individual Families, based on Total Family Income (TFI) and established fee ranges. By law, military child care fees are based on TFI, not military rank or civilian grade.
2. The updated policy, which is released at the beginning of the school year, will be effective on **1 November 2015**, for the SY15/16. Patrons may see an increase in their fees for Child Development Centers (CDCs), School Age Care (SAC), Family Child Care (FCC), Middle School & Teen Programs (MST), SKIES *Unlimited* Instructional Programs (SKIES), Youth Sports & Fitness, and Community Based Programs.
3. Major changes in the SY15/16 Army CYS Services Fee Policy include:
 - a. Child Development Care Fees: All Europe Garrisons are on the CDC Standard Cost Fee Structure. Fee difference for Full Day: Cat 1-9 \$4.00-12.00 monthly increase. No Change in part day fees.
 - b. SchoolAge /Kindergarten and Middle School Teen Fees: Increase of \$10.00 for Cat 1 &2 but a decrease for Cat 3-9 of \$8.00-\$20.00
4. We continue to move toward consistent fees at all Army, Navy, Air Force or Marine installations. The single fee structure across DoD minimizes the financial impact on Families while meeting the intent of Congress that all Families pay a share of their work-related child care expenses.
